## <u>Methodology</u>

Using random sampling, we sent out text message invitations to an online voter survey with the above questions. Text message invites made up 81% of our final results, with the remaining 19% being done via landline (15%) and cell-phone calls (4%). The results then go through a 2-step weighing process to match expected turnout, as projected in the demographics section above. The margin of error of 4.6% reflects the concentration of voters surveyed in State Legislature districts which we have prioritized polling.
